I am solely responsible for producing a website using Dynamics 365 Portals that will fully integrate with both PiedmontNG.com and the new Dynamics 365 implementation to provide a self-service and seamless user experience for both residential customers and commercial partners that will help to grow the gas business.

My responsibilities included ensuring the delivered product exceeded the expectations of the business, creating designs based off of the business requirements, facilitating communication between various organizations within PNG, managing the expectations of various stakeholders, managing when and how work would get done on the website and ultimately building the website which was a Dynamics 365 Portal website built using HTML5, CSS3 (SASS), JavaScript, JQuery and Bootstrap. The end result is a fully custom Dynamics 365 Portal website that provides integration with Dynamics 365 for a self service user experience as well as a seamless experience from the core PiedmontNG.com website and the new Dynamics 365 portal website.
